

SOCIAL MOBILISATION PROGRAMME

The Social Mobilization programme facilitates the involvement of churches and other social formations, bringing them into contact with the disadvantaged communities. The programme further enables leaders and community members to ensure that they support the disadvantaged communities and effect the improvements required.

In order to increase the support for the struggles of the poor and participation in social and economic justice by the church agencies and partner organizations, ESSET creates public awareness around issues of socio-economic injustices. These we achieve by producing and disseminating an accessible digest of social and economic justice from a theological and church perspective under the theme "Give us this day our daily bread". We also facilitate a church based campaign to affirm and promote the dignity of the marginalized communities.

ESSET create spaces for church leaders, ecumenical activists, leaders of impoverished communities, CBOs and other stakeholders to reflect on their work in relation to the socio-economic context. We mobilise the church to walk with people in their struggles for justice; build leadership for social change at all levels in the church and enable dialogue through which the poor church can challenge the rich church.
