

STRENGTHENING LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME

The Strengthening Leadership programme provides leadership training and develops interventions to equip the target group to work for socio-economic justice. One of the tools used to achieve the purpose of this programme is training course called the Training for Socioeconomic Transformation (TSET). This training course takes place in three separate weeklong module sessions, with two-month periods between each training week. During the two-month break periods, delegates work within their communities to put their newly learnt strategic tools into practice. Depending on the scope and complexity of key challenges identified, ESSET may work with delegates in specific communities to develop the necessary strategies to overcome the root causes of chronic socio-economic injustice.

Over and above the training course, ESSET develops training in response to specific needs as identified by communities. If necessary, existing materials are modified and adapted to meet the needs of a community or new materials developed.

ESSET believes that even the poorest of South African communities can be empowered to successfully fight their own way out of poverty and social injustice, with the support of the church and community leaders.
